



The Friends of Nore Barn Woods

Formed in 2002, The Friends of Nore Barn Woods is a group of local Emsworth residents who aim to conserve and make the woods more pleasant for the general public. The Friends are affiliated to The British Trust for Conservation Volunteers and work in partnership with Havant Borough Council who are responsible for the woods as an open public space.

Over the last five years The Friends have:

- Cleared some of the overgrown areas, creating glades to increase habitat diversity.
- Planted over 700 tree and hedge saplings to replace dead and dying growth.
- Raised grants of £14000 to resurface the Wayfarers Walk.
- Successfully liaised with HBC to ensure that hedges are cut back and grass areas mown.
- Worked with the local police to minimise vandalism.
- Planted over 3000 native bluebells to replace the Spanish (garden) variety.

Ongoing Projects:

- Campaigning and raising finance for restoration of the Southern shoreline bank that is suffering severe erosion
- Working with the HBC Arborist to ensure the long-term survival and viability of the woods
- A quarterly Newsletter emailed or hand delivered to all Members
