This section of the shore of Nore Barn Woods, to the west of Emsworth, is suffering very serious erosion from the sea. The Friends are driving the project to complete the shore conservation work started in 2011.

The cost of this future work has risen to over £46,000. There is no public money for this as no houses are under threat, but we can apply for grants, and appeal to local individuals and organisations for their support.

We have collected £30,000 already, but we still need to raise at least another £16,000 by July 2014 so that the work can proceed in September/October 2014. This is our final big push on fundraising. Please help us protect this beautiful coastline for future generations.
